Rules, Classification and General Information

NOTICE - By the act of classifying and participating, each shooter has indicated they assume and accept full responsibility, for themselves and their minor children, for bodily injury, death or loss of personal property and expenses as a result of inherent risks and dangers.

The shoot will be governed by the current National Skeet Shooting Association (NSSA) rules unless otherwise noted.

It is the responsibility of each shooter to declare their State of residence and to present their event classifications at the time of registration. Please check your classes prior to leaving registration. Mis-classified shooters who have not corrected their class prior to shooting an event forfeit all awards, purses, and option monies. No refunds will be given.

The Protest Committee for the Arizona Skeet Championships will be posted at registration. All protests must be filed in accordance with NSSA rules II-E-1 and II-E-2.

Entry for each event will be closed ½ hour prior to the designated start time of the last flight for that event. No refund of entry fees will be made for withdrawals due to weather or other non-emergency reasons.

All ties involving awards or honors will be shot-off by doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5, miss and out per station, unless otherwise indicated in this program.

ASSA and the shoot management reserve the right to change or modify the program as necessary. Any changes to the program will be posted and made available at the time of shooter registration.

Shoot management reserves the right to refuse entry, or disqualify, anyone who interferes with or disturbs the harmony of the shoot in any manner. Alcoholic beverages on the firing line are absolutely forbidden and will result in the expulsion of the offending contestant.

EVENT 2 – Doubles Main Event, 50 pair.

EVENT 3 – 12 Gauge Main Event, 100 targets

EVENT 6 - 410 Bore Main Event, 100 targets

Flight Times – 12:30 pm and 2:00 pm Entry closes

1:30 pm. \$60.00 including NSSA & ASSA fees.

EVENT 7 – High Overall (HOA) Event

400 targets taken from the cumulative scores of events 3-6. Awards are as stated in the program. Entries for this event close Saturday prior to a contestant shooting the 12 Gauge event. HOA classification follows the NSSA HOA classification table found in the NSSA rule book. No shooter shall be allowed to have an HOA classification lower than the lowest classification in any of their four gun classifications. No entry fee.

EVENT 8 – High All-Around (HAA) Event

500 targets taken from the cumulative scores of events 2-6. Awards are as stated in the program. Champion, runner-up, and three places will be awarded in classes AA, A, B, C, D, and E. Entries for this event close Friday, prior to a contestant shooting the Doubles event. HAA classification follows the NSSA HAA classification table found in the NSSA rule book. No shooter shall be allowed to have an HAA classification lower than the lowest classification in any of their five gun classifications. No entry fee.

Concurrent Events Offered in both Closed and Open Shoots

Concurrent events are offered with events 1 through 7.

Champ, Runner-up, and Third, and Group 1 first will be awarded in each of the individual concurrent events.

Individual Concurrent Events: Senior Veteran, Veteran, Senior, Sub-Senior, Sub-Sub-Senior, Triple-Sub-Senior, Collegiate, Junior, Sub-Junior, Novice, SCTP, First Responder, Lady, Military, Military Veteran, and Retired Military.

Team Concurrent Events: Two-Person Open Team, Five-Person Open Team, Five-Person Club Team, Husband and Wife Two-Person Team, Parent and Child Two-Person Team.

No fee will be charged for the above listed concurrent events, and awards will be honors only. All ties for concurrent Champ, Runner-up and Third will be shot-off. Group 1 first ties will be determined by long run.

OPTIONAL PURSE EVENTS

The following optional purses will be offered in conjunction with events 2 through 8 in both the unless otherwise noted. Optional purse monies will stay within each shoot

OPTIONS & PURSES

Oklahoma Options - \$15.00 per event. Split into \$5.00 per fifty - first, middle, and last. All money stays in class. All ties divide the purse, and all money is returned to the shooters. Not available for the HOA or HAA event (events 7 & 8).

Optional Class Purse - \$10.00 per event. All money stays in class. All money returned to the shooters. For 1-5 participants, one winner; for 6-10 participants, split 60/40; more than 10 participants split 50/30/20. Event Champ and runner-up will remain in class for the optional purse. Ties will be shot off.

Lewis Class Options - \$10.00 per event. Minimum of three classes, maximum of five classes. All ties in class divide the class purse. All money returned to the shooters.

Handicap Options - \$10.00 per event. The table below determines handicap for the event with a maximum score of 100. All ties divide the purse. All money returned to the shooters. Not available for the HOA or HAA event.

New Recognition Team Minimums for 2026!!!!

The Board of Directors voted unanimously to modify the required minimum targets for the **SUB-JUNIOR, JUNIOR, and SENIOR VETERAN** Age Concurrents. **This makes the requirements for the State Association consistent with the NSSA requirements.** For clarification, the following are age breakdowns for all age concurrent categories:

***CHANGES IN RED

The ASSA and NSSA Recognition Systems have minimum requirements for competition targets in each gauge. If you are interested in taking part in the various recognition programs, it's important to understand the criteria to qualify. The Arizona Skeet Shooting Association requirements are included in this program and if you have any questions, speak to a Board Member for additional information. While similar, the NSSA Recognition Programs are slightly different and you can look those up on the NSSA Website at: www.mynssa.nssa-nasca.org

Selection Criteria for All-State Teams (2025 and Prior)

1. The Arizona Skeet Shooting Association (ASSA) will recognize members of the Association for their shooting accomplishments annually by forming honorary All-State Teams for the current skeet year.
2. Members of the All-State Teams will be selected based on shooting proficiency for the previous National Skeet Shooting Association (NSSA) skeet year.
3. The ASSA will establish All-State Teams as follows:
 - a. Three Open teams (Open First, Second and Honorable Mention Teams) of five shooters each.
 - b. A Concurrent All-State Team for each concurrent recognized by NSSA. Each concurrent team will consist of five shooters.
4. Criteria for selection to the Arizona All-State Skeet Teams:
 - a. Be a resident of the State of Arizona for at least six months during the previous skeet year (the year for which shooting proficiency is being measured) and be a member in good standing of ASSA during that year.
 - b. Have shot at least the minimum number of targets established by NSSA for selection as an open or concurrent NSSA High Average Leader.
 - c. For selection to a concurrent All-State Team, meet NSSA criteria for that concurrent for the year during which shooting proficiency is being measured. If fewer than five members meet the criteria in each concurrent, only the members meeting the criteria will be selected.
5. Selection to All-State Teams shall be based on the shooter's High-Over-All (HOA) average for the previous skeet year. Statistics for Arizona residents will be obtained from NSSA by the secretary at the conclusion of each skeet year. These statistics will consist of the number of targets shot and the shooter's average for each gauge. The statistics should be obtained for all shooters as an aggregate and sorted by concurrent.

Eligible members with the top five HOA averages shall be placed on the Open First Team, members with the second five HOA averages shall be placed on the Open Second Team, and members with the next five HOA averages shall be placed on the Open

Honorable Mention Team. The following is the standard requirements of registered targets for the Open Team.

- a. For concurrent teams, except Junior & Sub Junior, eligible members with the top five HOA averages will be selected to each concurrent team. Members may be selected to more than one concurrent team if otherwise eligible. The following is the standard requirements of registered targets for the Concurrent Classification.

- b. For the Junior & Sub Junior Concurrent teams, the standard requirements of registered targets are:

6. High Average Leaders. The shooter having the highest average in each gauge (12 Ga, 20 GA, 28 Ga, 410 Bore and Doubles) shall also be recognized by the Association. Shooters must have shot NSSA Open Team minimums for the particular gauge under consideration (not necessarily for all gauges) to be eligible for the award in that particular gauge.

7. Awards.

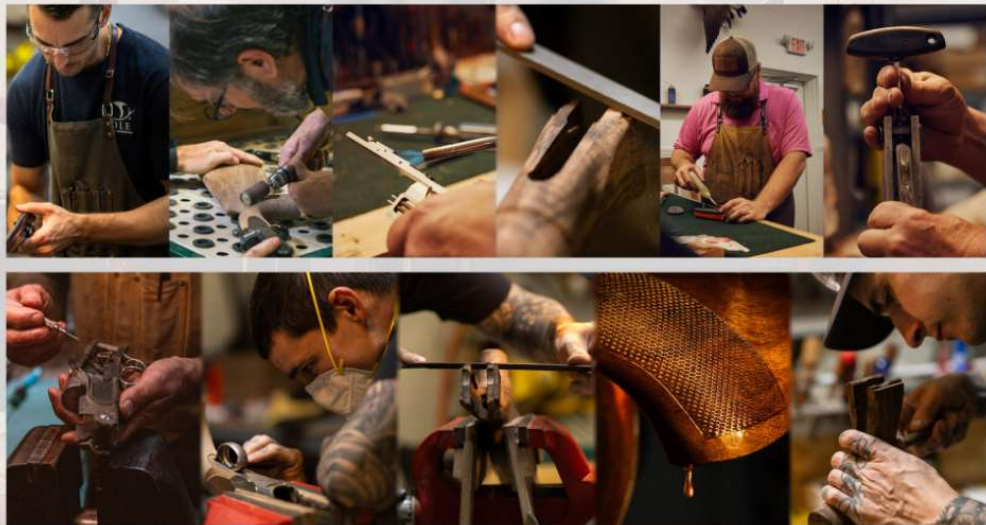
- a. Members selected to the Open Teams shall receive an award (medal, pin or belt buckle) plus an Association recognition certificate.
- b. Members of each concurrent team shall receive an Association recognition certificate.
- c. High Average Leaders in each gauge shall receive an Association recognition certificate.
- d. All members selected to an All-State Team shall have their names published in the State Shoot Program (if possible).
- e. Awards and certificates shall be presented to the recipients at an appropriate ceremony during the State Skeet Championships
