



Remembering Bruce Kinkner 1936-2021

For many of us who participate in the Sport of Skeet, Bruce Kinkner was the owner of Southwest Shooting Supply, a source of competition shotguns marketed from his home showroom in Phoenix. What went unseen to many was the almost six decades of participation, organization, and innovation Bruce brought to the sport. In the mid-60's Bruce was selling electrical supplies when his friend and co-worker Bill Howard introduced him to Skeet Shooting, opening the floodgates and unknowingly beginning a lifetime of involvement in the sport, in so many ways.




He joined the NSSA in June of 1966 and eventually amassed 230,909 lifetime targets, shooting his last registered targets at the 2010 World Championships and posting a score of 24/25 on his last box. Bruce was an accomplished competitor, winning many gun championships large and small at local clubs as well as around the nation, delighted to shoot 100 straight in a two-field club just as much as when he competed at the World Championships. Not satisfied with simply competing, Bruce became immersed in the organizational and promotional side of the sport, identifying opportunities for growth, particularly in the Western States. He was one of original founders of the Arizona Skeet Shooting Association and helped organize the first State Skeet Championships in Arizona. He didn't stop there, and ultimately brought the Western State Skeet leaders together in Salt Lake City to discuss and form what is now known as Zone 7, bringing representation of the western states to the NSSA and evolving into the first of many Zone 7 Championships. The rotation of the Zone 7 Championships from State to State encouraged many clubs to add fields so they could host the Zone shoot, having a dramatic impact upon the growth of the sport.

He organized the first Wells Fargo Open in Phoenix, which later became the Kachina and for the last 16 years is known as the Copper State Open. The Kachina is still remembered by senior skeet shooters as being the "go to" shoot in the Southwest, and many mantles are adorned with Kachina Doll trophies. EVERYONE wanted one of those Kachina doll trophies! The formation of the Old Pueblo Open in Tucson and the Comstock Open in Las Vegas resulted in the Southwest becoming a Winter destination for Skeet shooters, being able to register 2600 targets in just two weeks.

A member of the NSSA Executive committee for many years, Bruce became President of the NSSA for two terms beginning in 2000. His innovative drive while on the Executive Committee resulted in the rotation of the U.S. Open and corresponding NSSA meetings to various clubs around the country, improving perception by membership of the NSSA's support of members in all regions. The shoot-off doubles format (versus shooting countless regular rounds of skeet!) that we use today along with the Doubles Event itself is also the result of his innovative thought process and initiative.

In recognition for his efforts, Bruce was inducted into the NSSA Hall of Fame in 1983, receiving the Ray Boller Award for his contributions. He was subsequently inducted into the Zone 7 Skeet Hall of Fame in 1990 and the Arizona Skeet Hall of Fame in 2004, as part of the initial classes of recipients in these newly formed organizations. Bruce's love of the Game of Skeet far surpassed his personal shooting accomplishments throughout his adult life. He often had to fight for what he felt was right for the game, ruffling some feathers along the way, but always with the future in mind and helping grow a sport that he loved and that thousands enjoy today.

Rules and Information

Rules and procedures of NSSA and ASSA will be observed during this registered shoot.

Any protest of a referee's decision must be made on the field before the shooter moves to the next station. A Protest committee will be formed utilizing experienced shooters in attendance that will rule on all protests.

Score sheets must be signed by a member of the squad before leaving field. Shooters are responsible for verifying that classes entered and scores shot are correctly posted. Scores become final five minutes prior to shoot offs for that event. Shooters are responsible for ensuring they are entered in the proper class, desired events, concurrents, purses and options.

HOA Champ, HOA Runner-Up, HOA 3rd, Gun Champ, Gun Runner Up, & Third will be removed from class.



Shoot-offs for all HOA and HAA events will be shot with the .410.

Concurrent events will be shot in conjunction with regular shoot-offs whenever possible. Concurrent shoot-offs will be held for Champion, Runner up, and Thrid

All shoot-offs will be doubles at stations 3, 4, & 5, miss and out by station.

Standard shoot-off rules will apply in accordance with NSSA rules.

Management reserves the right to make program changes. Any and all changes will be posted on the scoreboard. Management also reserves the right to refuse or refund entries to persons who, in management's opinion, disrupt the harmony of the shoot.

OPTIONAL CLASS PURSE

Entry Fee: \$10.00 per events 1 thru 8. All money returned to class. One to five entries 100% to winner. Six to 10 entries split 60/40. more than 10 entries split 50/30/20.

LEWIS CLASS OPTIONS

Entry Fee: \$10.00 per event. Minimum of three shooters per class, maximum of five classes. All ties in class divide the class purse. All money returned to the shooters.

"OKLAHOMAS"

Entry Fee: \$15.00 per events. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6; All money returned to class.

HOA CHAMPIONSHIP

Entry Fee: \$10.00 Combined score of events 2, 3, 4, 5. Entry must be made before shooting event 2. All money returned to class.

HAA CHAMPIONSHIP

Entry Fee: \$10.00 Combined score of events 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6. Entry must be made before shooting doubles. All money returned to class.

12 GAUGE B, C, D, E CHALLENGE

Entry Fee: \$5.00. This is an <u>optional</u> purse in the 12G event open only to shooters who compete in classes B through E. All money is returned to any shooters who shoots a 25 straight in that event. Each 25 straight receives an equal share of the prize money.

CHAMP OF CHAMPS—By class, based on 4th round of each gauge. Entry Fee: **\$10.00**. Based on 4th round events 3, 4, 5, & 6.


